# New Evening and Weekend GP Clinics Service

Did you know that you can now book evening or weekend appointments with a NHS GP, Nurse or other health practitioner?

## Why has this new service been introduced?

The GPs in Oxford have set up a new service that provides additional appointments in the evenings and weekends. This makes it easier for patients registered with a GP in the city to receive advice or care at a time that is convenient.

The service is provided by a team of GPs, Advanced Nurse and Paramedic Practitioners, Clinical Pharmacists, Physiotherapists and Practice Nurses.

## What health advice or treatment can I get?

As well as offering medical advice and treatment on everyday health problems and long-term medical conditions, the team also provide nursing care, such as wound dressing changes, catheter care, blood sampling and cervical smears, and we have also introduced a new 'see and treat' physiotherapy service.

### **Are there some patients who shouldn't use the service?**

Although people with a wide range of health problems can use the new service, we recommend that you continue to see your own GP if you have an on-going problem that your GP or Practice Nurse is already looking after or have more complex health problems. If your Practice is closed and you need urgent advice, phone 111.

### **How do I get an appointment?**

Appointments are booked through your Practice reception. The Receptionist will also be able to advise you on whether or not the service is the best option for you or whether an appointment at the Practice would be better to meet your needs.

### **Where are the new clinics located?**

Evening and weekend appointments are provided at St Bartholomew's Medical Centre, Manzil Way, Oxford, OX4 1XB.

We also provide the service on various days and times at three further sites in Botley, The Leys and Summertown. Please see the back of this leaflet for further details.

### **How will the doctor or nurse know about my medical history?**

The GPs in Oxford have put in place a secure electronic records system that allows clinicians to use the same health record. This means the service doctor or nurse will be able to find out about your medical history and medications. Also, your own GP will be able to see any changes to your care made during your appointment. This shared system is available for any person registered with a practice in Oxford, as long as that person has consented to 'record sharing'. You will be asked whether or not you will allow your medical record to be shared when you book an appointment.

### **What if I don't give permission for my medical record to be shared with the Evening and**

### **Weekend GP Clinics Service's doctor or nurse?**

It is your right to choose, but if you do not give permission for your medical record to be shared then your Practice Receptionist will not be able to book an appointment for you with the service and you will be advised to book an appointment in your Practice instead.

### **Can I see a GP or nurse without an appointment?**

No – this is not a walk-in or an emergency service; all appointments must be booked in advance by contacting your local GP Practice Reception.

### **What if I prefer to see my usual GP?**

The Evening and Weekend GP Clinics Service may be able to see you sooner or at a more convenient time, however, if you wish to see your own GP please advise your Practice Receptionist.
